Within fifteen (15) days from the date that this Report and Recommendations of the Magistrate is sent to persons set forth below, either party may file an exception to this Report and Recommendations of the Magistrate pursuant to Rule 1.490 (i) of the Florida Rules of Civil Procedure and the procedures set forth in said Rule. This 15 days includes a 10 day period allowed for the parties to file such exceptions and a 5-day mail period. After 15 days, the Circuit Court will execute an Order adopting this Report and Recommendations of the Magistrate and said Order shall be final at that time.
