**Burglary reported of the Snake Pit on 1302 W. Waters Ave., Tampa, FL by Neil Gubitza, Proprietor.

REPORT

AT TAMPA, FLORIDA

On December 19, 2001 received a phone call from a person identifying himself as James Thornton. He stated he was calling from Rowlette, Texas, and that he represented a large grope of people in the U.S. that are Herpetologists and deal in snakes, lizards, turtles and the like. He stated that a business in Tampa known as the Snake Pit had been burglarized several times and that the people in his industry were tired of it all and wanted the person caught and brought to justice. According to Thornton, the proprietor of the store, Neil Gubitz had some good leads and was pretty sure who did it. He asked if I knew anything about snakes and/or lizards and I replied that I knew little about them other than the fact that they aren't my favorite pet. He asked if I liked animals and I replied that I did and in fact find it absurd that anyone would hurt any animal for any reason with the exception of protection ones self or the person of another. He stated he wanted me to investigate the burglary and I advised that I would.

He stated that he would have to contact a person in Tallahassee, Rich Zuchowski and get his approval. I advised I needed a \$1000.00 retainer to begin. He thought that would be no problem. He called back a short time later and stated that he had gotten approval from Mr. Zuchowski. He stated that he could only get \$500.00 together on that date but would have the rest in a day or two. I advised that I required a credit card payment and he gave me the credit card number with expiration date. He provided a Visa number [REDACTED] in the name of James Thornton.

On December 20 I faxed him a contract which he signed and faxed back. He advised the remainder would be available in a day or two. On the same day I went to the store and interviewed Neil Gubitz. The store was an absolute mess and did not appear to be the scene of a

burglary, rather than of a criminal mischief. There were broken tanks, animals all over the place including rats and snakes. There was also a couple of crushed small turtles on the floor. Gubitza appeared almost nonchalant about the burglary and advised he was waiting for his employee to show up to clean up the mess. He gave me a hair net of the type often seen used by black men and a bent key from the cash register. He stated there may be a print on the key.

Gubitza provided the name of Elronza Williams who lived a short distance away and stated he was pretty sure he did it. He also gave the following list of animals he stated was stolen;

18 Bearded Dragons. These were made up of the following;

- A. 2 Red Blood Tigers.
- B. 2 Yellow Sandfires.
- C. 2 Pure German Giants.
- D. 2 Normal Bearded Dragons, one of which was a female with a nipped tail.
- E. 1 6' Female Albino Boa, gravid.
- F. 1 7' Anery Thristic (No red)
- G. 12 Ball Pythons

He stated Elronza Williams lived in an apartment in Del Ray Apartments apartment 7D, 8725 Waters Ave., Temple Terrace. Phone number 989-2846.

Gubitza went on to explain that he called the TPD but as usual they were worthless and wouldn't investigate. He stated he provided them with a report but was convinced they wouldn't do anything and that's why he wanted a private investigator. He stated he had been thinking about this for quite some time and was convinced a PI would be his best bet.

Gubitza provided the name of Ginny Martenliz stating that she saw Elronza Williams that same night in her back yard dressed in black with a back pack on. When asked for particulars she was

reluctant to provide details stating she didn't really want to be involved. Her phone number is [REDACTED]. Another number is 955-2110.

On 12-21-01 The apartment of Williams was surveilled. No activity was noted. It was learned from a neighbor that he was moving. The neighbor also stated he knew the guy (Williams) had some snakes but didn't think he had any at the present time.

Gubitz was contacted with this information and he replied that he had a call from someone he couldn't identify and that this person stated that Dave Lawson was involved with a guy named Jake Tyner and that he heard Tyner had a very rare snake, a 6' Albino Boa Female that was gravid. He stated that it had to be his snake. He said he didn't know where Tyner was but that he thought he was in northern Florida somewhere. He added that he was sure Lawson knew.

Gubitz provided Lawson's phone numbers as H - [REDACTED]

C - [REDACTED]

Called Dave Lawson at his home. He was asked if he knew anything about the burglary and he stated he did not, but was suspicious that it was committed by Gubitz himself. He went on to say that he wasn't sure of my agenda and wanted to think about whether or not he should talk to me after he learned that Gubitz was accusing him.

The following people were interviewed on 12-20-01 with negative results;

Josephine Arnold, Josies Reptiles, 1000 West Waters. Her shop was spotless and her demeanor good. She answered all question in a forthright manner and seemed honest.

Joe Faucie, Southeast Reptile Exchange – He was busy and it was hard to interview him. He made a remark however that was a little off. He stated that if it did happen, he was sorry. He stated he wasn't there and wasn't going to comment any further.

Rita Maggio, Budget Pets, 3810 South Dale Mabry Hwy., Tampa, 82-1220. While at the store there was a large albino snake in a cage. The attendant said it was an Albino Boa. A call was placed to Neil at his store. He stated he would come right over to look at it. He arrived in about 20 minutes and stated it was not his and was in fact a Python. It seemed strange that he got there so fast from Waters Ave. He appeared relieved that it wasn't his snake and joked that I really didn't know snakes. During this time I waited outside the store. I explained I wouldn't know a python from a Boa. He stated there was no harm done and asked to borrow \$10.00 for lunch.

12-22-01

At the Del Ray Court Apartments looking for Elronza Williams with negative results.

12-24-01

Went to The Snake Pit and again talked with Neil Gubitz. It was explained to him that I was unable to get in touch with James Thornton. Gubitz stated he talks to him often and not to worry and that I would definitely be paid and he would see to it. He explained that Thornton's daughter was very ill and was hospitalized and had in fact been in the hospital for months. He said Thornton was staying at the hospital 24/7 with his daughter as she was not expected to live much longer.

12-30-01

Received an e-mail from James Thornton, Progressive Ideas/Faunaclassifieds.com.

He asked that I call and discuss the results thus far.

I returned the email and asked him to call me via telephone. I provided my telephone number.

I never received an email from Thornton and the above referenced email was the last I heard from Thornton to this day.

Over the next several weeks beyond New Years Day other attempts to contact Thornton were negative. Several messages were left with no call backs. Several calls were made to Gubitiz regarding this matter and he stated he had talked to Thornton and that he had my money. He stated he was going to make arrangements to have it sent to Rich Zuchowski to forward to me. That never occurred. Gubitiz was advised that Thornton had cancelled his credit card account. Again Gubitiz stated that he did in fact have my money and would be paying me in full in the next couple of days. Agin, that never occurred. In a subsequent call Gubitiz was told that Thornton owed me \$670.04. I advised that I was going to cease working on the case until I was paid in full for amounts owed and received another retainer before commencing any further work.. Gubitiz stated it was OK.

In the next few weeks Gubitiz would occasionally call and provide bits of information that seemed like far stretches in an attempt to place the blame on anyone he could. He continually blamed Rick Cole and that he was in with Dave Lawson. He stated he had an albino Boa for sale on the hush hush. He indicated that a person named Bill Thompson had snakes that were stolen by Ron (Elronza) Williams. He stated that a person with the last name of Lyman (Didn't know first name) is a do boy for Dave Lawson and holds stolen snakes for him. He was asked about Elronza Williams whom he was sure did it and that in fact was observed that night in what could

be described as burglar clothes and was seen by Ginny Martenz. He avoided the question and deferred to other conversation.

Over the next couple of months I received several calls from Gubitiz. He would always ask what was going on with his burglary. He stated he didn't have any insurance at the time. He said he had to replace all his stolen animals himself and that he never got any of them back. It was subsequently learned that in fact there were no animals stolen and that most of them were in fact in the store, re captured and put in tanks and cages by his employee and her friends.

He was now claiming that Thornton must have ripped North American Investigations off. He claims not to have had any contact with Thornton since the first of the 2002 year. It has been learned that his is in fact not true and he did have ongoing conversations with Thornton on many occasions. It was also learned that Gubitiz's father was sending money to him to replace his stolen animals. This came to light from Gubitiz's father himself in a telephone conversation. He further stated that it looked like his son may be staging the burglaries himself. I explained to him that I was constrained by state law from talking about the particulars of the case.

Just previous to the above phone call it became very apparent that Gubitiz was being dishonest in almost every instance I had ever talked with him, including the very first interview when he made statements that were not true regarding missing animals. He had made accusations in an email to the Faunaclassifieds Board of Inquiry Group about my investigation that were on the verge of being civilly actionable. Gubitiz was told in early May not to call me relative this case any more and that if he did I would file charges against him and have him arrested.

Information from reliable persons who are very close to the situation at hand have provided particulars which completely controvert everything that Neal Gubitiz has offered in this case.

It is my professional opinion that Gubitz knows who committed these crimes and it is increasingly likely that he had part in them himself. Physical as well as circumstantial evidence tends to support this theory.

1. He deliberately removed any possible latent from the register key by swiping it to destroy any possible latents.
2. He did not file a police report himself to the TPD when requested to do so at the time of the burglary. This is always the best time to solve a case, right after it happens.
3. He provided so many different supposed leads in the couple of weeks subsequent to the actual burglary that it was hard to focus on or identify any one suspect.
4. Gubitz lied on many occasions when he stated he wasn't having conversations with Thornton. It has been substantiated that he in fact did.
5. The Yellow Sandfires were not in the store the night of the burglary. They had been previously sold.
6. The 6' Albino Boa Female was not gravid and was in fact ill and was being injected daily with Gentamicin Sulfate.
7. Gubitz would not allow the police to dust for prints in the store.
8. Gubitz's father and mother who are directors of the corporation that owns the Snake Pit.

9. Neil Gubitiz is the Registered agent, a physical address where the Secretary of State can contact the corporation for maintenance reasons.
10. Neil Gubitiz's Father and Mother did not know Gubitiz had an employee, Angie Coker who actually runs the store and does the bookkeeping. It was she and her friends that cleaned the store after the burglary.
11. No insurance checks for the previous burglaries ever went through the books according to his bookkeeper.



12. An upgraded security system was installed in the store. It was frequently unhooked. The cameras are hooked to the monitor, but not the recorder. Therefore, if an illegal entry was made there would be no recording.
13. He was overheard many times in telephone conversations with James Thornton after the first of the year and as late as the end of January.
14. Store manager Angie Coker stated she had seen the hair net that Gubitiz game me on the ground several days before the burglary. Gubitiz stated he found it on a shrub by the alleged point of entry. It must have jumped up on the shrub!

3/10/02

Met Rich Zuchowski at the Florida International Reptile Show. This meeting was actually not very fruitful. I explained to him that it was my opinion that everyone was ripped off by James Thornton. I further advised that I was very suspicious that Gubitiz knew more about the whole thing than he was letting on. He agreed and stated he was also suspicious that Gubitiz may have more responsibility in the whole matter than earlier thought. Zuchowski stated he felt responsible for the remainder on my bill and that he would like to pay it. I advised that it would in fact be a better idea to repay on a percentage basis all that could be identified as contributors. He agreed.

On May 011, 2002 I received a check from Rich Zuchowski in the amount of \$670.00 for payment in full of the account. He was written a letter of appreciation.

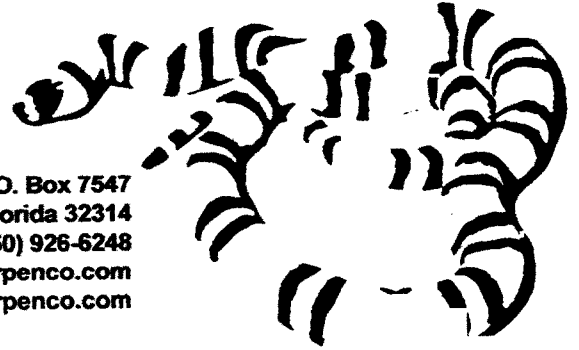

Please find a check enclosed for \$670.04 which reflects payment for the balance due on the work you did investigating the break-in during the month of December, 2001 at Neil Gubitz's pet shop. As previously mentioned, I would like to have a copy of your findings of this investigation, if you are legally able to do so. I have indicated that I would like to make this information public, but will only do so with your permission.

If you are not able to accept this payment as closure for the above mentioned case, please consider this as prepayment for \$670.00 worth of effort to investigate the possibility that Neil Gubitz was directly involved in the break-in of his shop on the night of May 1, 2002, as well as the one in December of 2001.

FYI, I was contacted by Neil's father (Jay Gubitz) on 5/08/02 and he is apparently taking an interest in what is going on. The really curious thing about this is that he said that James Thornton called him to let him know what is going on and told him a lot of details. One detail being that James said he sent Neil the balance of the money that was to be paid to you. Something doesn't sound right about all this. Why would James pop up out of nowhere to contact Neil's father, much less even know how to find him in the first place? I did find it interesting when Neil's father said that it is HIS store and not Neil's, so this puts a new light on things for me. But at this point I'm not sure whether Jay Gubitz contacted me after prompting by Neil or if he is truly taking an interest in what his son is up to with his store.

Thanks for your help and I am sorry about the hassles this has involved you in.

Mr Crowley: let me introduce myself. My name is Jay Gubitz, and my wife, Elaine, and I own Jandeg, Inc., which does business under the name of The Snake Pit (of Tampa, FL). Our son, Neil runs the store.

This past Wednesday, May 8, I received a call from a James Thornton which disturbed us greatly. What parents want to hear their son accused of theft and fraud?

After talking with Rich Zuchowski, and Neil, I have discounted much of what Mr. Thornton told me. Neither Mr. Zuchowski nor Neil can account for the money so generously raised to pay for your services. Neither one has heard from or can contact Mr. Thornton. The only thing that Mr. Zuchowski did know was that you received a retainer of \$500 from Mr. Thornton, but he didn't know how it was paid. He was never given an accounting for the rest of the money (or for other funds he claims Mr. Thornton owes him).

He told me that he was going to pay the balance of your unpaid bill out of his own funds.
If he doesn't, we will.

We know that you did a lot of investigative work, and that you prepared a report. Mr. Zuchowski never saw it, and doesn't know who might have. Since we are the owners of the company for which you were doing the investigation, we would very much like you to share the results with us. Even if it means, as Mr. Thornton so strongly implied, that it involves our son.

If there any expenses involved in complying with this request, please send us a bill - beforehand, if necessary.

I would be real curious to know if this, in fact, happened, and someone else wasn't pretending to be James Thornton in order to muddy the waters even further. James had absolutely no reason to contact Mr. Jay Gubitz that I can think of, and this all smells rather fishy to me. How many people even knew that Neil's father actually owned the shop or would have had a clue how to reach him? Not many, I am sure.

BTW, I thought you might like to see this email I received from Neil back in February. Imagine the pickle I would now be in if I had gone along with his proposal.....

Posted: Feb. 28 2002,17:47

Rich...First of all...IF we decide to TELL ALL...I would suggest we DON'T do it until AFTER the Tampa show, for obvious reasons!!
BUT....Everyone put money in to try and catch the culprit, correct?? Why don't I just put out a thread saying that the guy has been caught, but I can't go into ANY DETAILS because of the investigation and eminent trial??? This will take EVERYTHING and make it SWALLOWABLE, at least! I figure....why cause trouble?? Why not just let everyone feel like they made a difference and WELL be the ONLY one's to know the truth??
What do you think??? ...Neil

In subsequent conversations with Angie Coker, the store manager, she stated that on numerous occasions Neil made the following statements to her; (These are not direct quotes)

1. "You are either with me or against me."
2. "If you don't support me I'll commit suicide"
3. "Fuck the Police" when asked why he purposely destroyed what may have been fingerprints from the register key. The day that Gubitz was originally interviewed he pointed to the key in the register that was twisted. He stated he was sure there was a print on it and carefully removed it and put it in an envelope. He said the police didn't want it. In fact, it was later learned that he deliberately wiped any possible prints from the key with his fingers in front of the store manager and told her to keep her mouth shut after she suggested he give it to the police to dust it.
4. "I'm not going to make a report". He then threw report in the garbage. It appears below.

Statement of account from Northdale Animal Hospital showing the amount of \$82.00 paid to treat and medicate the 6' Albino Boa that Neil Gubits said was stolen and was gravid. Both hospital and store manager Coker state that the snake was not gravid, therefore the value was much less than Gubitz reported to the insurance company.

Two fax messages from Criti Care Diagnostic Laboratory at 3000 Busch Lake Boulevard which were retrieved from the garbage. The reports are for both snakes and shows that they were critically ill, dying and worth very little.

The next four (4) pages are documents referred to above.
